

Privacy Notice – Project Events

Dear User,

Pursuant to Art. 13 of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), the following intends to inform the User (hereinafter the "Data Subject") about the characteristics and means of processing of any personal data provided to Fondazione Toscana Life Sciences, Impactaml project partner, by participating in events with video and/or photo shoots for dissemination and/or promotional purposes of the project.

Controller

The Controller, for the processing subject of this information, is Fondazione Toscana Life Sciences (hereinafter Fondazione), with registered office at Via Fiorentina no .1 - 53100 Siena, email: privacy@toscanalifesciences.org

Types of Personal Data Processed

The categories of personal data subject to processing include also sensitive personal data (photographs images, videos and/or recordings). No audio recordings will be made. For any interviews conducted, the interviewees will be provided with a release and separated privacy notice.

Purposes and Legal Grounds of the Processing

The data provided by the Data Subject will be processed for the purpose of publicising the event and the activities of the Impactaml project: during the events organised for, video footage and/or photographs may be taken by the Data Controller and/or videomakers expressly authorised, in order to promote the events on websites and/or social profiles (e.g. Facebook, YouTube, Instagram, Twitter, etc.), radio, TV, newspapers, magazines, brochures and printed promotional material.

The legal basis for the processing is the legitimate interest of the data controller or, where applicable and/or necessary, the consent of the data subject.

Scope of Communication and Dissemination of the Personal Data for the Pursuit of the Purposes of the Processing

The data may be communicated to:

- *subjects internal to the Data Controller*, for the purposes of their respective competences, who will process the data in their capacity as persons expressly authorised to process the data, such as employees and/or collaborators;
- *subjects external to the Data Controller*, duly appointed, who will process the data in their capacity as Data Processors of the processing such as: companies or professionals (journalists, photographers and/or videomakers) that may be appointed to take videos and/or photographs, to promote events on websites and/or social profiles, radio, TV, newspapers, magazines, brochures and other printed promotional material; companies, consultants or professionals that may be appointed to install, maintain, update and, in general, manage the Controller's hardware and software or which the Controller uses to provide its services; companies, consultants or professionals (such as legal, administrative and tax consultants) that may be appointed to install, maintain, update and, in general, manage the Controller's hardware and software or which the Controller uses to provide its services; companies, consultants or professionals (such as legal, administrative and tax consultants) that may be appointed to provide services. legal, administrative and tax consultancy firms, etc.), if the communication is necessary or functional to the correct fulfilment of the contractual obligations undertaken in relation to the services provided as well as the obligations arising from the law;

- *third parties, autonomous Data Controllers* for any legal obligations or specific requests by the Judicial and/or Public Authorities. Photographic images and video footage may, in line with the purposes of their collection, be disseminated through various channels on the Internet, TV, radio, the press, etc.

Mandatory or Optional Provision of Personal Data

When filming and/or photography are generic and include several people and concern activities carried out during Impactaml project events, participation in the event entails consent to the processing given unless otherwise explicitly denied.

To indicate that you do not wish to be filmed during the event, please contact the easily identifiable Controller's staff present in the conference room.

Data Retention Time

The photographic images and video recordings (No audio recordings will be made) will be kept in the Data Controller's archives, in relation to their possible use for the purposes indicated, for a period of five years after the end of the Impactaml project. In the event of requests for cancellation, modification or opposition by the data subject, the Data will be kept exclusively for administrative and management purposes for a period not exceeding 45 days, without prejudice to any specific legal obligations or public security purposes. After this period, the Data will be definitively deleted or transformed into anonymous form.

Data that cannot be controlled by the Data Controller and that are disseminated through the press or on the web (Facebook, You Tube, Instagram, Twitter, etc.) are excluded.

Place of Data Processing and Transfer of Data Outside the European Union

Data processing connected to the services provided by the Site are carried out at the offices of the Controller. Your personal data may also be transferred, limited to the above-mentioned purposes, to countries outside the European Union. This transfer takes place through the publication of the images/videos on social platforms.

Rights of the Data Subject

If allowed by the applicable legislation, the Data Subject has the right to: access his/her personal data (art. 15 GDPR), update or rectify his/her personal data (art. 16 GDPR), request the deletion of his/her personal data – right to be forgotten (art. 17 GDPR), limit the processing of his/her personal data (art. 18 GDPR), obtain his/her personal data in electronic format - right to portability (art. 20 GDPR), to object, for legitimate reasons, to the processing of one's personal data (art. 21 GDPR) - subject to any dissemination not controllable by the Controller - following such a request, the Controller may no longer proceed with the processing of personal data, except in cases where laws and regulations allow it. The Data Subject may assert his or her rights by contacting the Data Controller in writing to privacy@toscanalifesciences.org. The Data Subject also has the right to lodge a complaint with the Control Authority in charge of personal data protection.
