Detailed Information Notice



1. WHO PROCESSES MY DATA?

The Data Controller of your personal data is the Romagnolo Scientific Institute for the Study and Treatment of Tumors (IRST), with registered office in Meldola (FC), via Piero Maroncelli 40. You can contact the Data Controller via:

2. HOW CAN I CONTACT THE DATA PROTECTION OFFICER (DPO)?

3. FOR WHAT PURPOSES ARE MY DATA PROCESSED AND WHY IS THE PROCESSING LEGITIMATE?

The provision of your personal data is necessary to send communications, invitations, and updates regarding research initiatives, scientific dissemination, and events in the field of onco-hematology. These may not be directly related to the IMPACT-AML project but are thematically aligned with its scientific scope.

4. TO WHOM ARE MY DATA COMMUNICATED?

Your personal data will not be communicated.

5. ARE MY DATA TRANSFERRED OUTSIDE THE EUROPEAN UNION?

Your data will not be transferred abroad.

6. FOR HOW LONG ARE MY DATA KEPT?

The Data Controller will keep your personal data until October 30, 2035.

7. WILL I BE SUBJECT TO PROFILING?

Your data will not be used to obtain information about your preferences or behaviour, nor will you be subject to any decision based solely on the automated processing of your personal data.

8. WHAT ARE MY RIGHTS?

You have the following rights:

- **Right of access to data:** the right to obtain confirmation from the Data Controller as to whether or not your personal data is being processed and, if so, to gain access to your personal data and receive information about the processing.
- **Right to rectification of data:** the right to obtain from the Data Controller the correction of inaccurate personal data concerning you without undue delay and the completion of incomplete personal data, also by

providing a supplementary statement.

- **Right to erasure of data:** the right to obtain from the Data Controller the deletion of personal data concerning you without undue delay if one of the following reasons applies:
 - The personal data is no longer necessary for the purposes for which it was collected or otherwise processed.
 - You revoke the consent on which the processing is based, and there is no other legal basis for the processing.
 - You object to the processing, and there is no overriding legitimate reason to proceed with the processing.
 - The personal data was unlawfully processed.
 - The personal data must be erased to comply with a legal obligation to which the Data Controller is subject.
 - The personal data was collected in relation to the offer of information society services.
- **Right to restriction of processing:** the right to obtain from the Data Controller the restriction of processing when one of the following applies:
 - You contest the accuracy of the personal data for the period necessary for the Data Controller to verify the accuracy of such data.
 - The processing is unlawful, and you oppose the deletion of the personal data, requesting instead that its use be restricted.
 - Although the Data Controller no longer needs the personal data for processing purposes, the data is necessary for you to establish, exercise, or defend a legal claim.
 - You have objected to the processing, pending the verification of whether the Data Controller's legitimate reasons prevail over yours.
- **Right to data portability:** the right to receive in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format the personal data that concerns you, provided to the Data Controller, and to transmit such data to another Data Controller, where the processing is based on consent or a contract and is carried out by automated means.
- **Right not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing,** including profiling, which produces legal effects concerning you or similarly significantly affects you.

You may exercise your rights by sending a request to the Data Controller's email at privacy@irst.emr.it. The Data Controller will respond as soon as possible and, in any event, no later than 30 days from your request.

9. AM I OBLIGED TO PROVIDE MY DATA?

You are free not to provide your data to the Data Controller. However, if you do not provide your data, you will not receive communications, invitations, and updates regarding research initiatives.

10. HOW CAN I FILE A COMPLAINT?

If you wish to file a complaint about how your personal data is processed by the Data Controller, or about the handling of a complaint you have already lodged, you have the right to submit a claim directly to the Supervisory Authority.
